









Respect the historic context of campus and surrounding neighborhoods while cultivating new connections both locally and regionally.



CENTERPIECE FOR ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

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PARDEE HALL OPPORTUNITIES

- Activate first floor through improved seating to provide more studentfriendly collaboration/study areas (including increased electrical outlets).
- Create a visible home for interdisciplinary programs through the creation of hubs with spaces for students and faculty to gather.
- Showcase as model for academic excellence with modern classroom technology and flexible furnishings





OPPORTUNITY FOR CENTRALIZED STUDENT SERVICES

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CENTER FOR PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Relocate Career Services from Hogg Hall into a modern space, accessible to all – students, faculty, staff, alumni, industry partners, and community members.
- Provides potential alignment between Skillman Library 1st Floor renovation and Markle Hall to bring together student services in a more centralized location to create a one-stop shop for student services.
- Located in a prominent position on the Quad and on axis with new Welcome Center, and in proximity to parking.
- Opportunity to provide large assembly space on ground floor of new facility.




WILLIAM E. SIMON CENTER (JENKS HALL) OPPORTUNITIES
